

Harlequin Quilt

Requirements

Finished quilt approximately 58" square

You can use different fabrics in one colour way or as many different colours as you wish.

1.2m of Calico or other background fabric for foundations

Fabric strips in at least 7 colours cut in strips measuring from 1" to 2.1/2" wide. The total amount of fabric should be equal to 4 fat quarters but if you want the string pieced border then add extra fabric, between 5 and 6 fat quarters in total.

30cm fabric for first border

40cm fabric for second border

Strip piecing for third border

50 cm for the fourth border

Fabric for binding depending on your method of binding.

Any of the borders can be omitted or their measurements changed depending on your design.

Wadding and backing fabric to be determined once the quilt is finished.

Sewing machine.

Sewing cotton to tone with fabrics

Ruler, a square ruler is very handy but will need to be at least 7.5" square, and a long ruler if you need to cut strips.

Cutting mat and rotary cutter

Sewing machine, (I used my walking foot to join the squares!)

Marking pencil

Usual sewing kit
